Lesotho - "The Mountain Kingdom"

Located high in the mountainous regions of Southern Africa, Lesotho - also called "The Mountain Kingdom" and "The Kingdom in the Sky" - is completely surrounded by the country of South Africa. The Basotho people who call this region home eek out a living as herdsmen and farmers and it is their story and the stories of the missionaries who serve them that we have been asked to help tell.

A team from Daylight Media Ministries will be joining a team from Africa Inland Mission next month in Johannesburg, South Africa. From there, we will travel on to Maseru, Lesotho to shoot two documentary videos to capture these fascinating stories that will inform, challenge and encourage the church.

One assignment will involve capturing and telling the story of how God is using agricultural training as a vehicle to improve the lives of the Basotho people and reach them with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The second project will tell the story of a nomadic population of shepherds. Young boys become responsible for their herds at an early age - some as young as five years old. Because they travel with their flocks in search of good pastures, the shepherds generally don't get to attend school. There is an opportunity to reach them with literacy and discipleship programs.

The objective of these documentaries is to share these exciting opportunities through the stories of God's work in and through His servants there. We are taking a small, two man team from Dallas so we can multiply the efforts of our ministry partners from Africa Inland Mission. OFM Media Team Needs

The OFM team in Nairobi has several needs that we would like to help with, so we are taking steps to raise funds to help provide them with additional resources that will enable them to be more effective in their work. 100% of the

donations designated for OFM will go directly to their work.

Electrical power is something we take for granted here, but in Africa, it is less certain. This creates challenges when editing video. As a backup, they need a 5,000 Watt generator capable of producing 50Hz 230 volt power - estimated cost \$1,500.
